Who can use eRemit?

Anyone with a eNETS enabled bank account*

**Current or Savings account of DBS/ POSB/ UOB/ Citibank or Standard Chartered.*

How to use eRemit?


1. Log on to <https://eremit.sbising.com/>
2. Enter your eRemit User ID, Password and click SUBMIT.
3. Enter Beneficiary details and INR amount for remittance.
4. Check your entry and confirm SUBMIT.
You are seamlessly directed to the eNETS gateway for payment.
5. Choose your preferred bank from the drop down menu (DBS/ POSB/ UOB/ Citibank or Standard Chartered).
You are seamlessly directed to the INB portal of your preferred bank.
6. Login into the INB portal of your bank and complete the payment.
7. Transaction is complete and online receipt is issued by your bank confirming the debit of your account.

Prerequisites

1. Registered eRemit Customer.
2. Holder of eRemit User ID & Password.
3. Internet banking login User ID, Password and Security Device of your preferred bank.*

** Current or Savings account of DBS/ POSB/ UOB, Citibank or Standard Chartered.*

To register for eRemit

1. Log on to <https://eremit.sbising.com/> and click the  tab.
2. Complete and submit the online Remittance Registration Form.
3. Upon receipt of eRemit USER ID and an acknowledgement email for successful submission of details, please visit any SBI branch with:-
 - ✓ NRIC.
 - ✓ Passport and Employment/ Dependent/Work Pass.
 - ✓ An address proof (eg: Utility, Telephone bill etc) will be required if the work pass doesn't carry the address.
4. The eRemit Password will be emailed to your registered address upon completing the registration process.

1. No new bank account need to be opened.
2. Existing accounts in DBS/ POSB/ UOB/ Citibank or Standard Chartered can be used for payment via the bank's internet banking portal.
3. Available any day, any time at the click of a button.
